Call to Order: The regular meeting was called to order by Chairman Devine at 6:00 p.m.

<u>Verification of Public Notice:</u> Clerk verified public notice was given on May 12, 2022.

Town Agenda: Motion by Kayartz/Cawley to approve the agenda as posted. All in favor by call of roll.

Road Bid Opening: The Town Clerk opened the bid/proposal envelopes from D.L. Gasser Construction, Payne & Dolan, and Tri-County Paving Inc. and read them aloud. Motion by Pate/Kayartz to accept the lowest bid for Raymond Road from D.L. Gasser Construction in the amount of \$91,682.85. All in favor by call of roll.

Building Permits Report: Provided.

Road Report: Supervisor Cawley reported on seal coating and crack filling estimates/proposals. He also reported on the Summit Drive plowing complaint.

<u>Cemetery Report:</u> Sexton Cawley reported there were no recent lot sales or funerals. The mower will eventually need all new belts, front deck wheels with hardware, and a left side handle safety switch.

<u>Solid Waste & Recycling Center Report:</u> Supervisor Cawley attended the May 4th meeting. There were no complaints. Supervisor Cawley spoke with Greg Kaminski about the trash along Highway 16. A crew was sent to pick up the trash.

Building & Grounds Report: Dennis Crawford mowed the Town Hall property.

Sheriff's Report: There were 167 calls for April.

<u>Correspondence</u>: The Columbia County Planning & Zoning Director sent a letter to the Town regarding Big G Enterprises LLC extension request of the 60-day review period for the current Conditional Use Permit request. The letter referred to Town Engineer Roth's Guidance Memo dated April 25, 2022, also included in the packet. Discussed recent in person meeting with owners of Big G Enterprises.
