

MINUTES OF TOWN OF PACIFIC SPECIAL BOARD MEETING

Thursday, November 5, 2020 5:30 PM Held at the Pacific Town Hall

Call to Order: The special meeting was called to order by Chairman Devine at 5:30 p.m.

Roll Call: Chairman William Devine and Supervisors Irma Brockley, Craig Cawley, Steven Pate, and Steve Paulk were present.

Others Present: Clerk Gustafson and Town Attorney Miller were also present.

Verification of Public Notice: Clerk verified public notice was given on November 2, 2020.

Consider whether to call a special Town meeting for the purpose of considering whether all candidates, in the Town of Pacific, for elective Town offices, shall be nominated at a nonpartisan primary: It was explained why many towns have changed from the caucus system to the primary system for elected town officials. The primary system is generally considered to provide a more even “playing field” for those seeking elective town offices. Motion by Cawley/Brockley to call a special Town meeting on Friday, November 27, 2020, for the purpose of considering whether all candidates, in the Town of Pacific, for elective Town offices, shall be nominated at a nonpartisan primary. Motion passed with Brockley, Cawley, Pate, and Devine in favor and Paulk opposed. Motion Pate/Cawley to hold the special Town meeting at 6:00 p.m. Motion passed with Brockley, Cawley, Pate, and Devine in favor and Paulk opposed.

Adjourn: Motion by Brockley/Pate to adjourn at 5:53 p.m. All in favor by call of roll.
